Job purpose

Work as a clinical technical expert in a research study evaluating introduction of thermal ablation to cervical cancer prevention services in reproductive health clinics.

Responsibilities

- Train reproductive health providers on cervical cancer screening and treatment of pre-cancer lesions (specifically VIA/VILLI, thermal ablation and cryotherapy procedures).
- Support continued education and engagement with reproductive health providers in cervical cancer prevention clinics.
- Generate reports and maintain study records
- Lead trial working group meetings as required.
- Participate in resolving monitoring findings and queries.
- And any other duties as assigned.

Education and Professional training

- Diploma in Clinical Medicine or Nursing
- Trained on cervical cancer screening and treatment with experience in providing reproductive health clinical services
- Registered by the Nursing or Clinical officers Council

Experience

- Minimum of 3 years' experience with direct involvement in patient care especially in cervical cancer screening and treatment
