KEMRI invites applications from dynamic and innovative individuals to fill the following project contract positions under the Department of Epidemiology, Statistics and Informatics (DESI)

1. Bachelor of Science in Biostatistics

The Intern will be trained in the following:

- i. Implementation of research projects and/or supervising designated aspects of the work;
- ii. Carrying out fieldwork and laboratory experimental procedures;
- iii. Organization of the internal scientific seminars;
- iv. Interpretation and validation of results;
- v. Maintaining the scientific laboratory in good working condition; and
- vi. Ensuring that all chemicals, reagents and consumables are properly stored in the laboratory.

In addition, the applicants must:

- i. Be a Kenyan youth below 30 years of age.
- ii. Should have graduated and obtained the relevant final certificate.
- iii. Provide a Certificate of good conduct.
